


Land containing 2,400 square yards or thereabouts situate at Buckland Newton in the County of Dorset and having a frontage of 75 feet or thereabouts on the west to the road leading from Dorchester to Pulham being part of the land numbered 422 on the Ordnance Survey map (1902 second edition) with the building thereon known as the Buckland Newton Village Hall being the land comprised in a conveyance dated the 10th June 1947 and made between John Douglas Chick of the one part and Alan John Ernest Edelsten and another of the other part and recorded in the books of the Charity Commissioners on the 1st September 1947 pursuant to section 29(4) of the Settled Land Act, 1925.
